

WHAT IS COGS?

COGS is a union that represents graduate TAs and RAs at the University of Iowa, committed to improving the standard of living of all TAs and RAs. COGS is not a political party and is not affiliated with any political party.

COGS was established in 1996 and since then has fought hard to win the benefits we have today, including the tuition waiver, 50% reduction in mandatory fees, and GRADCARE.

WHAT DOES COGS DO?

■ The University of Iowa and COGS negotiate a contract that

- determines your pay, health care benefits, and other rights and benefits. COGS members vote on what goes into our contract.
- COGS also helps TAs and RAs file grievances when their rights under university policy or our contract have been violated.
- COGS is also fighting everyday to secure more wins. The issues we are currently focused on are winning an emergency wage increase and abolishing fees.

CAN INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS JOIN COGS?

YES.

Every international graduate student, regardless of national origin or type of visa, has the right to join a union. Your right to belong to a union is protected by the right to freedom of association guaranteed in the United States Constitution.

And as a TA or RA, you are a public employee of the state of lowa

and are protected by the Public Employee Relations Act of the State of Iowa, which states: "Public employees shall have the right to:

- No one can threaten your standing in your academic program.
- 1. Organize, or form, join, or assist any employee organization.
- 2. Negotiate collectively through representatives of their choosing.
- 3. Engage in other concerted activities for the purpose of collective bargaining or other mutual aid or protection. . . . "

This means that you can join and participate in the union without fear. Under the law:

- No one can threaten your job or benefits
- No one can threaten your stay in the U.S. (e.g., you will not be deported, or have your immigration status changed or revoked)

WHY SHOULD INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS JOIN COGS?

International students make up a third of all TAs and RAs and are a vital part of COGS. Domestic students and international students face many of the same kinds of issues: not enough pay, workplace exploitation, overwork, etc. But international students are faced with them more severely, making their perspectives critical.
